
## Pennsylvania Brings in \$4.49 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of March were \$4.49 billion, which was \$86.7 million more than expected.

Collections of \$2.36 billion for corporation taxes came in above Department of Revenue projections by \$29 million. Sales tax collections of \$745 million were higher than expected, coming in \$24.6 million above the official estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$1.1 billion, which was below estimate by \$1.6 million.

Year-to-date General Fund collections of \$22.24 billion are above the official estimate by \$147 million.
