
## Pennsylvania Brings in \$1.94 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of May were \$1.94 billion, which was \$25 million less than expected.

Collections of \$81 million for corporation taxes came in below Department of Revenue projections by \$20 million. Sales tax collections of \$791 million were higher than expected, coming in \$9 million above the official estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$773 million, which was below estimate by \$44 million.

Year-to-date General Fund collections of \$27.84 billion are above the official estimate by \$97 million.

## **General Fund Revenue vs. Estimates**


