## Pennsylvania Brings in \$4.4 Billion in Revenue Collections

General Fund revenue collections for the month of April were \$4.41 billion, which was \$465 million more than the Department of Revenue’s Official Estimate.

Collections of \$386 million for corporation taxes came in above the Official Revenue Estimate projection by \$90 million. Sales tax collections of \$975 million were higher than expected, coming in \$43 million above the Official Estimate. The Personal Income Taxes collected were \$2.52 billion, which was above estimate by \$331 million.

For the 2018-19 Fiscal Year, General Fund collections total \$29.16 billion year-to-date, which is \$828.5 million above the official revenue estimate. Tax revenue collections are 6.9% higher as compared to the prior fiscal year.
